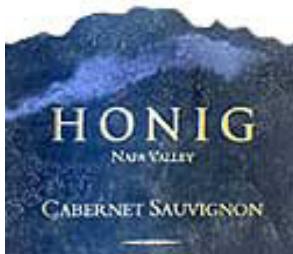

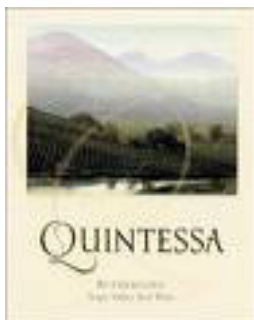

PETITE SIRAH

Durif is a variety of red wine grape primarily grown in California, Australia, France, and Israel. It is the main grape known in the US and Israel as **Petite Sirah** with over 90% of the California plantings labeled "Petite Sirah" being Durif grapes. It produces tannic wines with a spicy, plum like flavor.

RED WINES OF SPAIN

Tempranillo is one of Spain's most important red grape varieties, and is often thought of as Spain's answer to Cabernet Sauvignon. In Spanish "tempranillo" means early, which is why the grape was given that name, because it ripens earlier than most red varieties. It is the primary varietal used in Spain's popular Rioja wines, and only until recently was rarely used outside of Spain except for blending.

“Oenotria” is what the Greeks called this land over a thousand years ago. Meaning “the land of the vine” and with fifty thousand wineries....who can argue? Indigenous varietals provide the backbone, but classic international varietals are often blended in to encourage a broader audience.
